

REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Allan R. Andrews Scholarship

In 1993 the New England Regional Council of NAHRO established the Allan R. Andrews Scholarship Fund in memory of Allan R. Andrews who was the dedicated, creative, and effective administrator of the Springfield, Massachusetts, Redevelopment Authority.

Scholarships are awarded to both NERC/NAHRO member agency public housing/Section 8 residents & employees or commissioners or the immediate family members living in the household of said eligible individuals.

The Scholarship Committee awards scholarship money directly to the winning applicants once proof of registration at the college or university is received. The Committee will determine the number and amounts of the scholarships; no scholarship will be less than \$1,000.

Deadline to Apply: May 7

Massachusetts Past Presidents Memorial Scholarship

The MassNAHRO Past Presidents Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in remembrance of the individuals who have served the Association with dedicated leadership and professionalism.

Eligible individuals are residents (includes Section 8), employees or commissioners of MassNAHRO agencies or the immediate family members living in the household of said eligible individuals. For the purposes of this application, "immediate family" is limited to children, stepchildren, grandchildren, step-grandchildren and spouses.

The Scholarship Committee awards scholarship money directly to the winning applicants once proof of registration at the college or university is received. Individual scholarships as much as \$6,000 have been awarded in the past.

Deadline to Apply: April 9

John J. Kelly Memorial Scholarship

CONN-NAHRO will award several, \$3,500 scholarships to college-bound high school seniors and continuing college students who are residents of Connecticut public housing or Section 8 residents.

Eligible individuals are all persons who have been accepted into a two (2) or four (4) year institution of higher learning working toward a full-time Associate's Degree, Bachelor Degree, or full-time vocational training/certificate beginning in September 2020, and who reside in or are assisted with their housing by a CONN-NAHRO agency member, and; who are residents in good standing with their housing authority.

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

NAHRO Merit Scholarship

The NAHRO Merit College Scholarship Program awards \$1,000 each to eight scholars, one from each NAHRO region, who are pursuing their first post-secondary degree. Each NAHRO region submits an applicant of their choice from their own scholarship program. The regions' scholarship applications then are judged by the NAHRO Scholarship Committee, which is comprised of Housing America Advisory Committee members.

From these eight scholarship winners, the NAHRO Scholarship Committee will choose three candidates to become a part of the NAHRO-LDG Scholars program, which is a 10-year venture that will provide \$1 million in scholarships and internship opportunities to low-income students from around the country and is funded by the award-winning multi-family housing developer, LDG Development.

Of the eight regional winners, three candidates will be chosen by the NAHRO Scholarship Committee to be a part of the NAHRO-LDG Scholars program. NAHRO-LDG Scholars will receive:

- A \$12,000 scholarship distributed over four years to assist with tuition and fees;
- \$3,000 a year for up to three years, as a summer internship stipend;
- Networking opportunities with business and community leaders.

Scholarship funds for both NAHRO Merit College Scholarship winners and NAHRO-LDG Scholars are sent directly to the scholarship winner's accredited institution of higher education once proof of registration is received.
